
GETTING TO FORTY HALL FARM

Forty Hall Farm is located next door to Forty Hall, at the top of Forty Hill in Enfield.

The full address is: Forty Hall Farm, Forty Hill, Enfield EN2 9HA.



There is car parking at Forty Hall but please use public transport to visit the Farm if you can. There are three train stations nearby (Enfield Chase, Enfield Town and Turkey Street) and the 191 bus stops at the bottom of Forty Hill.

You can use the Transport for London Journey Planner to find the quickest route from anywhere in London. The website also has a dedicated cycling page, which can help you plan a route by bike. The website address is www.journeyplanner.tfl.gov.uk

ON ARRIVAL



Follow the signs for Forty Hall and turn in to the park through the stone gates. The car park is on your right.

If you are on foot or on a bike, take the road to the left, towards the Hall. Continue past the Hall and the banqueting suite, both on your left, and you will get to the Farm.

From the car park, there are two pedestrian routes to the Farm: around the lake, or past Forty Hall. The walk will take a maximum of five minutes.
